This is the stage in the writing process where you fix up your mistakes.



Have you ever seen an African elephant? They ate a massive land animal that roamed our planet.

## Capital letters

Check that you have **capital letters** in all the right spots.

- \* The first word in every sentence.  
*My teacher is a girl.*
- \* Proper Nouns - the names of people, places, things.  
*Stephen is the Captain of the Soccer Team in Year 6.*
- \* Where 'T' is by itself.  
*Cross and I went to the shops.*

## Spelling-

Check that your spelling looks right.

- \* Circle the words which you do not think are spell correctly.  
*I ~~want~~ the shop to buy some milk.*
- \* Check and correct your spelling by using a **dictionary** or the **word wall**.  
*spell ~~want~~ for the shop to buy some milk.*

## Punctuation-

Check that your sentences have been punctuated correctly.

- \* Question Marks ? - are used at the end of sentences asking questions.  
*Did you break your pencil?*
- \* Full Stop . - are used at the end of a full sentence.  
*I go to school.*

## Punctuation continued-

Check that your sentences have been punctuated correctly.

- \* Exclamation Marks ! - are used at the end of filling sentences that show surprise or excitement.  
*Look out!*
- \* Commas - are used to separate words in a list. Mrs Williamson bought some fancy feathers, pencils, skipping ropes and bubbles for her surprise box.
- \* Speech Marks " " - go around words to show what someone is saying.  
*"Bring me your book," said Mrs Meng.*

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
